To: MEPs of the Environmental Committee I

The chair of the Environmental Committee I of the European Parliament proposes below an agenda for the upcoming meeting pertaining to the Regulation on Preventing Plastic Pellet Losses to Reduce Microplastic Pollution. The outline contains the topics to be discussed by MEPs in Environmental Committee I as well as the topic discussed by MEPs during the joint session of the Environmental Committee I and the Environmental Committee II. This will also include any decisions by the chair in regards to the operation of the meeting that the Chair deems necessary for MEPs to be aware of. The timing and contents of this proposal are subject to change based upon the flow of debate. All votes in sub-committees are not final votes. They will determine the proposals that are brought to the joint session, which is where final votes will be taken.

Friday Meeting #1

The meeting will begin with the Environmental Committee I rapporteur Jorge Buxadé Villalba presenting the rapporteur report in regards to articles to be discussed in ENVI I. The Commission will then have a chance to respond to the presentation with their own.

If time allows, we will proceed to discuss article 4 and annexes I & III, following this order. The theme of this article and annexes are core obligations and risk management.

Friday Meeting #2

The Committee will finish the discussion in regards to article 4 and Annexes I & III. It will then vote on each article and annex separately.

If time allows the Committee will begin any discussions regarding articles 9 and 10 on the topic of incident response and corrective measures. It will then vote on each article individually.

Friday Meeting #3

The Committee will after it has discussed articles 9 and 10 begin discussing article 14 and 15, to discuss accountability and justice matters. It will then vote on each article individually.

Friday Meeting #4

The Committee will continue its discussion of articles 14 and 15 if necessary, otherwise it will start to discuss articles 16, 17 and 18, following this order. The topic of these articles concern compensation and flexibility for updates.

Saturday Meeting #1

The Committee will finish discussion of previous day articles and discuss article 19 concerning the entry into force and application. It will vote on every article separately.

Saturday Meeting #2 (Joint)

The Joint Committee will discuss and vote on the full proposal in order to ensure continuity. It will address any unresolved questions or overarching issues.

Saturday Meeting #3 (Joint)

The Joint Committee will conclude its voting on the full proposal.
