

Call for Applications

Doctoral Fellowship in the History of Christianity, Antisemitism and Philosemitism in Europe after 1945

The project **Christosemitism: Christian Anti-Antisemitism in Europe, 1945-2020** is offering two fully funded PhD fellowships at the Hebrew University Department of Comparative Religion for a period of up to five years, commencing between **February and October 2025**. The candidates selected will dedicate their work to historical and theoretical research that will examine some of the following topics and their interconnections:

- Resistance to antisemitism in Europe after 1945
- Religion, secularism, and secularization in Europe after 1945
- Contemporary Christian philosemitism in contemporary Europe
- Interfaith tensions in contemporary Europe
- The shift of the center of gravity of Christianity from Europe to the global south.

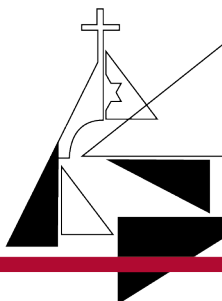
We welcome candidates from diverse fields such as European history, religious studies, theology, Jewish studies, philosophy, political theory, cultural studies, Holocaust studies, postcolonial theory, and sociology, provided they have an interest in studying the intersections of antisemitism, religion, and post-1945 European history.

Scholarship Terms:

- The fellowship duration is a maximum of five years.
- The fellows will receive a monthly stipend of **8,000 NIS**, along with additional support for fellows relocating from abroad.
- Further funding for travel to archives and conferences will be available upon approval.
- Fellows will be provided an office at **Mount Scopus Campus in Jerusalem** and are expected to be present in the office for **three full days per week**.

Position Requirements:

1. Advanced skills in at least one European language beyond English.
2. Proven experience in studying religion, antisemitism, contemporary theory, late-modern European history, or other relevant topics.
3. Strong interest in and aptitude for teamwork.

- Curriculum vitae (CV)
- Letter of application describing your motivation and qualifications (1-2 pages)
- Official academic transcripts and certificates (scanned copies)
- At least one writing sample (academic paper, essay, or publication)
- A list of two referees, including contact details. Referees will be contacted directly for leading candidates, and will be asked to provide letters of recommendation in a relatively short time.

Applications will be reviewed beginning in mid-December 2024. Outstanding candidates will be invited to an online interview.
