Prevent plagiarism with SafeAssign

SafeAssign is a tool that helps doctoral researchers to learn about plagiarism and proper source citation. This programme compares submitted papers or dessertations against a set of academic papers to identify areas of overlap.

The Antwerp Doctoral School developed a **manual** on SafeAssign for doctoral researchers. This will help you to do your research in accordance with the principles of **scientific integrity** as endorsed by the University of Antwerp.
