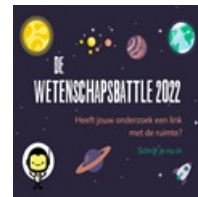
Sciencebattle 2022

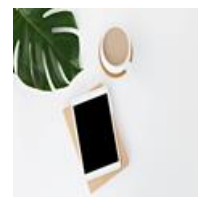


Digital Detox
