Special sessions can bring together researchers around emerging themes, methodological advances, or policy-relevant questions, enriching the overall scientific program.

In addition to regular submissions, we invite proposals for **special lecture sessions**, interactive **poster presentations with extended content**, **panels**, **round tables**, and **pitch sessions**. Session initiators are free to suggest the format they perceive as the most suitable.

All proposals for special sessions will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee of the STI-ENID 2026 Conference to ensure their quality, relevance, and contribution to the conference's thematic focus.

Proposals for special sessions should include:

- A description of the session theme (max. 3,000 words, incl. a short abstract of 50-150 words)
- Relevance and significance of the theme to the conference
- A description of the format
- A list of contributors and titles
