



Double degree with Valencia



Double degree ?

- Total duration: 4 years instead of 3 years (240 ECTS)
- Students receive two degrees:
 - SES (UA) + Business Administration & Management (UValencia)
 - SES (UA) + Economics (UValencia)
- 2 years in Antwerp, 2 years in Valencia (or vice versa)
- UA students submit application in the first semester of Year 2

1. Double degree SES Uantwerp – Business Administration & Management UValencia

- Term agreement: academic year 2025-'26 untill 2028-'29
- Total duration: 4 years 240 ECTS
- Subscription and tuition at UAntwerp
- Year 1 & 2 @ UAntwerp
- Year 3 & 4 @ UValencia (selected students are entitled for an Erasmus scholarship for 12 months in total)
- Maximum 3 students allowed in this double degree programme
- First selection of students: semester 1 academic year 2024-25
- Fixed program



2. Double degree SES Uantwerp – Economics UValencia

- Term agreement: academic year 2025-'26 untill 2028-'29
- Total duration: 4 years 240 ECTS
- Subscription and tuition at UAntwerp
- Year 1 & 2 @ UAntwerp
- Year 3 & 4 @ UValencia (selected students are entitled for an Erasmus scholarship for 12 months in total)
- Maximum 3 students allowed in this double degree programme
- First selection of students: semester 1 academic year 2024-25
- Fixed program

Selection

- **Selection** of applicants
 - Selection criteria: based on equality, academic merit and ability, past work and extracurricular experiences, motivation. Maximum of 3 students.
 - Decision before start of semester 2
 - Administrative change of courses semester 2
- Admission requirements
 - passed a minimum of 108 ECTS credits
 - passed the course 'Academic English'
- Administration checks requirements after exams in first and second semester

How to apply?

- Application
 - Transcript of records
 - Motivation letter (max. 1 A4)
- Mail application to <u>exchange.fsw@uantwerpen.be</u> and <u>doubledegree.fbe@uantwerpen.be</u>
- Deadline: 20 December 2024
- **Selection**: after the January exams (on time to apply for Erasmus grant by mid-February)

Erasmus grant?

- Selected students are entitled for an Erasmus scholarship for 12 months in total
- Not sufficient to cover all expenses, but it helps:
- Amounts:
 - Regular monthly Erasmus scholarship is €369
 - If you receive Flemish study grant, monthly Erasmus scholarship is €619
