We use hydroponics recirculation systems and keep on developing our knowledge and method throughout our different systems, year after year.

We want to deepen our understanding of the chemistry of our fertigation system and improve its management. We already have tools and protocols in place, so you won't be starting from scratch, but helping us improve them!

We have a very fertile and polyvalent playground for research and experimenting, on theoretical and practical levels.

If it would interest you, there is also a possibility to work directly in the vertical farms, taking care of the plants and the strawberries (and the bumblebees if you're lucky with the timing) and acquiring data.

We will adapt the internship depending on your skills and the ones you want to develop, to make this internship a win-win situation.
