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CALL FOR PROJECT

- Call for project launched by the French General Direction of Health (DGS)
- Expérimentation for the development of vaccination against the infections caused by human papillomavirus (HPV)
- Main aim : increase the HPV immunization coverage



CALL FOR PROJECT

I regions selected : French Guyana and Grand Est

2 main actions :

→ Training of healthcare professionals allowed to vaccinate

→Organization and achievement of immunization campaign inside middle-school

French Guyana : unusual territory

- Located in South America
- With 90% of the area covered with forest
- All the infrastructure based on the narrow coastline
- With 20% of the population living along the two border rivers



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French Guyana : unusual territory

- A very young population
- With multicultural and multilingual factures
- Including many indigenous communities
- Frequently using traditional medicine





HEALTH SITUATION IN GUYANA

- Marked by a lack of healthcare professionals
- Mainly based on the littoral
- Health Center in isolated areas



HPV Epidemiology in French Guyana

 Cervical Cancer is second most common of female cancer

High prevalence rates of HPV infection





HPV Infection risk factor

• Early sexual activity

• Sexual relations with multiple partners

- HAS Recommandations : cervical cancer screening must begin at 20 years old
- But very limited access to cervical smears testing





HPV Infection risk factor

• Low HPV immunization coverage

• Low access to immunization

• Many people without social insurance



PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION

Located in isolated areas

For:

- health-care professional working in the local health structures
- Parents
- Pupils



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PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION

- Training of health mediators
- meeting with the parents to inform them about the project
- Health professionnals training
- Information to pupils
- First vaccination campain



PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION: parents information

- Meeting parents in their village
- pirogue as the only means of transportation

 Going to the different villages as a 4-day journey





PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION: parents information

 Information about cervical cancer and immunization

 Explanation about parental consent

 Breaking down the language barrier through a mediator translation





PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION: students information

- Information to STI and method of prevention
- Information to cervical cancer and immunization
- Answering questions





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PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION : professionnal training

- Drafting of a training programme for health professionals : doctors, midwives, nurses
- Accreditation by the National Agency for the continuing professional development
- Lasting 4h



PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION : professionnal training

- Main learning goals:
- Understanding the interest of HPV vaccination
- What to do with vaccine hesitancy
- Understanding vaccines effectiveness and their limitations
- indications, contraindications and side effects





PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION : professionnal's formation

 Participation of all the health professionals

 Assessment of the effects of training : 100% good or excellent





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PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION : immunization campaign

- Participation of school health professionals from coastline (doctors and nurses)
- Immunization sessions planned over 2 days in the school infirmary
- Getting parental consent form signed



PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION : immunization campaign

 86 girls vaccinated on 246 registred on the first day

Project developed before authorization by HAS on boys immunization



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PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION : immunization campaign

- organizational difficulties
- Role of social networks
- Role of churchs





PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION : immunization campaign

Impact of the health crisis(second planned immunization dose in june 2020)

High mistrust about vaccines and health professionals (recent phenomena)
