 - February (prep from November)

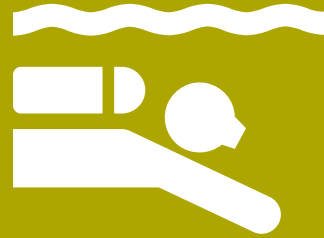

- Extra elective from existing programmes (FSS)
- Specific modules offered by FSS professors to HP students
- Individual trajectory (“IBT”): chose what you want to do, guided by a FSS professor or post-doc (e.g. via MOOC)

BROADENING

- Summer school
- Extra elective from existing programmes at UAntwerpen
- Extra 'korfvak': university wide - interdisciplinary - broadening
- Extra elective from YUFE programme
- Individual trajectory, guided by a UAntwerpen professor

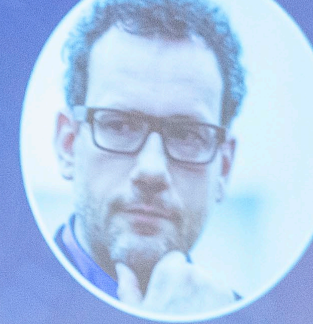

You on average score well.

You have a central theme in mind and you manage to compose and plan your individual trajectory

PASS/FAIL system



- PASS = minimally score 12/20
- Pass for every module or fail everything
- No second chance
- Opportunity to spread exams over time (1st/2nd exam period, summer school, internship...)

You are in charge of planning and implementing your own honours trajectory!

Explore the website

Mail @ coordinator

- Express interest via e-mail and mention:
 - Why interested?
 - Central theme + composition of your honours programme
 - Educational programme and year, roll number
 - Recent overview of scores (attached)
 - Not everything figured out? Pose questions and request an exploratory talk

Motivation letter

- All figured out? Write a motivation letter and send it to the coordinator

Candidacy accepted?

- You will be invited to fill out the template of the learning agreement
- Signature by coordinator formalized your participation
- Administration will initiate your enrollment as HP student
