INVITATION TO THE PAX JUDICIAL TRAINING

Paris, 4 and 5 March 2024

Dear Madam or Sir,

In November 2020 a consortium consisting of six leading European universities and a research institute launched an EU funded research project PAX – Private International Law in Motion. The PAX Project was designed with the firm belief that private international law plays an increasingly important role both in the work of legal professionals and in the lives of European citizens. In light of this, the project focus is to increase the awareness and knowledge of this highly relevant legal field among the legal professionals and among law students.

To achieve these goals, the PAX Project consists of two main activities: ***PAX Judicial Training*** and ***PAX Moot Court***. While the latter aims to increase students' awareness of European Private international law, the former focuses **on judges and trainee judges** and represents a tool to provide them with continuously updated knowledge on the EU legislative instruments on judicial cooperation in civil matters with cross-border implications. Both activities are interlinked, as the topics of this year's PAX Moot Court competition also represent the topics of our judicial training.

We are therefore pleased to invite you to attend the **PAX Judicial Training**, which will take place in Paris at the **Université Paris Dauphine-PSL on 4 and 5 March 2024**. This two-day judicial training course will consist of short lectures and workshops by some of Europe's leading academics in the field. The topics will include selected issues regarding jurisdiction and applicable law to cross border contracts and tort claims and participants will be able to apply their knowledge to hypothetical cases. Please find attached a **provisional program**, which you can share with your colleagues, and we would be honoured to have you join us.

As regards the practical arrangements, the participation at the PAX Judicial Training is **free of charge**. The PAX Project will be able to **partially cover the travel expenses** of participants. Furthermore, we will be able to **cover the expenses for accommodation (to a maximum of two nights)**. Were you to accept our invitation, we would be happy to provide additional information.

Deadline for expression of interest to attend is **15 February 2024**. Please, note that the number of participants is limited, and earlier registration will be given priority. A certificate of participation may only be issued if the entire training has been attended. In case of confirmed registration, we kindly ask you to make sure that you will be able to attend the training in full.
