The program focuses on:

- 1. Religious leaders (imams, pandits, pastors, rabbis)
- 2. Chaplains/consultants and teachers
- 3. Professionals in settings with religious diversity, such as healthcare facilities, police, education, ministries, and businesses
- 4. Anyone who wants to build bridges between different traditions and understand diverse perspectives

#### What does Emouna offer?

Each course day offers high-quality lectures and interactive group work. Education is provided by religious leaders and academics, as well as politicians and professionals from the public and private sectors. This interaction between philosophy of life, academia and society creates a unique learning environment.

The course covers topics such as Religion, Government and Law, Social Engagement, Communication and Social Networking, Interpretation of Sacred Texts, Leadership and Management, Professional Ethics.
