

Call for papers – PhD workshop on law reform in secured transactions and insolvency proceedings

On 23 September 2022 doctoral researchers are invited to participate in a PhD workshop at the University of Antwerp in Antwerp, Belgium.

Topic of the PhD workshop

The PhD workshop will focus on research in the large domain of law reform in secured transactions law and corporate insolvency proceedings. The research may cover historic, current, future or proposed law reform efforts concerning secured transactions and/or corporate insolvency proceedings in one or more jurisdictions.

Set up of the PhD workshop

At the PhD workshop doctoral researchers will have the opportunity to present their ongoing research to an expert panel including prof. Neil Cohen (Brooklyn Law School, USA), prof. Orkun Akseli (University of Manchester, UK), prof. Florence George (UNamur) and Prof. Matthias Storme (KU Leuven). The PhD workshop aims to create a stimulating environment in which PhD researchers can present their current research and receive valuable feedback from their peers and experts in the field.

In the afternoon the participants are invited to a masterclass in which the experts will present a topic related to their ongoing research in secured transactions and corporate insolvency proceedings.
