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#### **Cold War**

Importance international stability

- East versus West communism versus capitalism – left versus right
- Third World: aid and alliances

Strong relation Foreign Affairs and Aid

- (Inter-)national interests (political/economic model) → trade-off and tension with political situation on the ground in third world countries
- Importance freedom/democracy and human rights: high in discourse, low in action






#### 1989... The victory of democracy...

- Collapse of Sovjet-Union
- Due to internal (civil society) and external pressure
- More than 80 countries take steps toward more freedom
  - Internal movements for democracy
  - International pressure
  - Events in neighbouring countries
- Today 140 out of 200 countries organize elections







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### Lifting up taboos

- Less international tension
- Talking about politics and political abuse was no longer a taboo
- International organisations could speak up, publish reports, be critical about governments in the South AND donors in the North
- More breathing space between foreign affairs and aid
- Donors could include political change in their aid agenda

Doesn't matter	14	17	20	21

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


## But...

- Democratisation and the crisis of democracy
  - Civil wars, intra-national wars, ethnic violence
  - Decline of trust in stable democracies
  - Rise of extremist/fundamentalist movements
- Transiting versus consolidating democracy
  - Lapses into authoritarianism
  - Limited transition
  - Eternal transition
- The blooming of pseudo-democracies or anocracies

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#### **Anocracy: characteristics**

- Elections
  - not really open/fair
  - opposition rarely wins
  - fraude
- Executive & bureaucracy
  - authoritarian governing styles
  - little or no accountability
  - high on corruption
  - lack of transparency, little audit/control,
  - inefficiency
- Parliament
  - dysfunctional, a rubberstamping institution,
  - low on capacity
- + little or no results on economic progress, human development, poverty reduction




#### Desillusionment in the minds of people

#### 2006 – voice of the people


"Do you feel that elections in your country are free and fair?" "Would you say that your country is governed by the will of the people?"



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
#### 2004 – voice of the people



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#### 2005 – democratic world & lacking results





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#### **Desillusionment in the mind of donors**

 The contrast with miracle economies ... => not democratic yet performing relatively well

#### HOW TO DEAL WITH THESE CONTRASTS?

- Maybe it isn't as much about democracy (elections) as it is about good governance?
- ⇒ Good governance: committed government, high on technical capacity, …

Being a developmental state 'bread matters more than belief' 'results matter more than principles'



## Post 9/11

- Confirms the diagnostic and analysis: politics matters !
- Results matter more than principles...
- Poverty and instability
  - $\rightarrow$  breeding place for terrorism
  - → Migration
  - → International security issues
- Aid as an instrument for tackling governance issues
- Aid and foreign affairs become more intertwined
