LETTER DATED 22 SEPTEMBER 1995 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to resolution 1012 (1995), in which the Security Council requested me to establish, as a matter of urgency, an international commission of inquiry in Burundi.

I should like to inform you that, in accordance with the resolution, I have appointed five internationally respected jurists as members of the Commission. They are Mr. Edilbert Razafindralambo (Madagascar), who will chair the Commission; Mr. Abde El Ali El Mounni (Morocco); Ambassador Mehmet Güney (Turkey); Mr. Luis Herrera Marcano (Venezuela); and Mr. Michel Maurice (Canada). The curriculum vitae of each of the jurists has already been made available to the members of the Council.

As soon as the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions approves the Commission's budget and once the support team which will accompany the Commission to Bujumbura is formally recruited, I will ask the members of the Commission to assemble in New York before they start their mission. The Council will be kept informed of the progress achieved in this regard.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Council.
