## COMMUNIQUE N° 035 OF CNDD-FDD PARTY OF AUGUST 28th, 2015

1. The **CNDD-FDD** Party congratulates the new Cabinet Ministers to whom His Excellency the President of the Republic has put his confidence and who took the oath on August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2015. The appointment of these Cabinet Ministers took into account the various recommendations of the Heads of State of the East African Community member countries such as the establishment of a Government of a large opening in accordance with the article 129 of the Constitution of Burundi and the ruling of the constitutional Court N° RCCB 312 dated August 17<sup>th</sup>, 2015;

The **CNDD-FDD** Party appreciates the fact that the new Cabinet has been established with due respect of the Constitution and the Arusha Peace and Reconciliation Agreement, especially in terms of respect for ethnic and gender balance. Political parties, members of defense and security forces, neutral persons in the defense and justice, members of a coalition of independents, representatives of journalists and women associations representatives all have been appointed to participate in a such Government of a large opening ;

3. The **CNDD-FDD** Party is also grateful to the fact that women have been highly considered in the new Cabinet. Indeed, 6 key Ministries among the 20 were given to women. For instance, we can mention the Ministry of Education, Higher Learning and Scientific Research combining two former Ministries, which is under the headship of a woman, providing an eloquent evidence that gender is significantly valued in our country;

The **CNDD-FDD** Party urges the newly appointed Cabinet Ministers not to disappoint the Burundian People and to start their work as soon as possible because the task ahead appears heavy. It expresses its support to them and reminds them that their job priorities must focus primarily on peace consolidation, national reconciliation, good governance and sustainable development that will build on the decentralization process;

The **CNDD-FDD** Party concludes its remarks by urging the International Community to continue supporting Burundi by cancelling the decisions that have led to suspension of some budgetary supports to Burundi, because such penalties against the People have no more meaning after the establishment of a Government of a large opening and the assurance to continue the dialogue in an internal framework usually designed and used by Burundians for ages.
