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Citylabs LA: Rationale

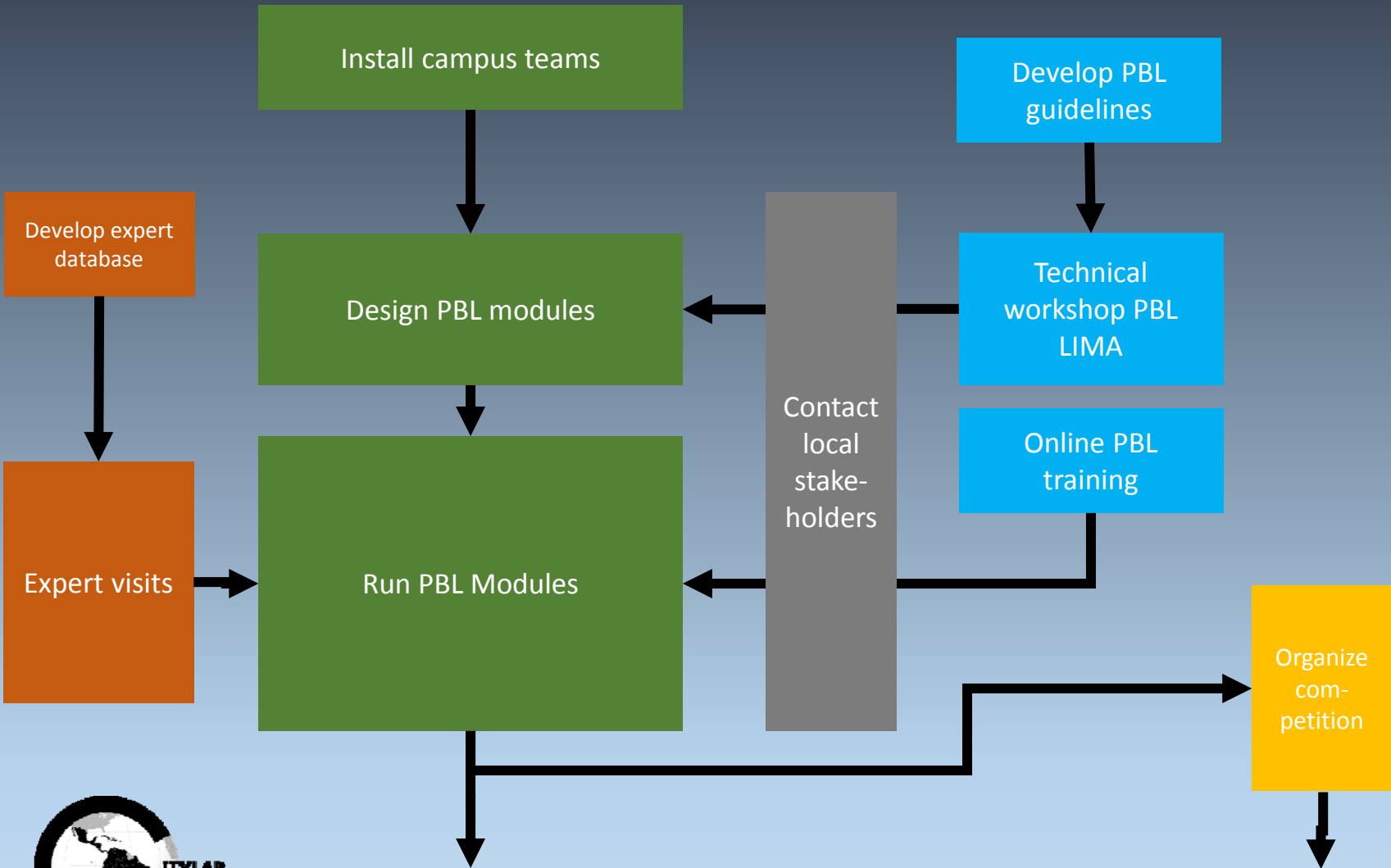
- Overall goal?
 - Erasmus +, key action 2: Innovation in **Learning methods**
 - through Problem Based Learning (PBL)
 - to create networks between HEI's and societal actors, focusing on sustainable cities
- Why problem based learning?
 - Traditional learning methods (ex cathedra) have relatively poor performance
 - PBL learns from real life problems and closes the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical knowledge
 - PBL is focused on the application of knowledge and skills and student-oriented
 - PBL strengthens competences in interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary approaches



Citylab modules

- Use PBL methodology
- Are developed and ran by Campus Teams at each university
- Are (transformed) courses part of existing curriculum
- Are interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary
- Focus on complex problems attaining SDG's in cities
- Involved in the CITYLAB student competition
