  - SDGs (Sustainable Development Goals)
  - More issues of concern than "health" as such
  - Diseases of poverty

# Health and developmental impact

- Comprehensive/holistic approach/projects/interventions
- AIM: Break Vicious Circle of Poverty -> sustainability

- Well-thought specific strategies, e.g.:
  - Closed/protected/elevated fire place: Reducing burns
  - Closed cooking stove (micro-credit project)
  - Solar cooking

⇒Change cooking habits
⇒Change lifestyle/food habits → diabetes, hypertension

- Self-representation groups
   ⇒ADVOCACY => lobbying: MPs
- Village Savings and loan associations

- Well-thought specific strategies, e.g.:
  - Barefoot college/solutions in India (TED-talk):
  - Support women's aspiration to transform themselves and their communities
  - → to improve village life from all angles, wherever poverty exists.
  - Solutions: e.g. solar power, education, clean water, professions and advocacy.
  - Mega-L: electrification (solar panels)

- Well-thought specific strategies, e.g.:
  - Community Based Rehabilitation (CBR)
    - to help people with disabilities, by establishing **community-based** programs:
      - for social integration,
      - equalization of opportunities,
      - Physical therapy **rehabilitation** programs for the disabled
    - Umbrella concept (health, livelihood, empowerment)
    - Assessment of the needs of the target group

- Core group members
- Side-meetings @ international congresses

#### How to increase funding?


- Core/primary project => core/primary funding
   financial leverage\* or co-financing
- Extra components => extra funding
- Basket funding: pro's & con's (governance)
- Earmarked vs. undesignated funding
- Fundraising team: donor research







TABLE 1	Actors in impact bonds in developing countries
Role	Types of organization
Outcome fun	Foundations or philanthropists; multilaterals, bilaterals or intergovernmental financial institutions (IFI); governments; non-profits; corporate giving; investment funds
Investors	Foundations or philanthropists; multilaterals, bilaterals or intergovernmental financial institutions (IFI); impact investing firms; banks; investment funds; institutional investors
Service prov	Nonprofits, international organizations, nongovernmental organizations, development organizations, charities, impact investors, community organizations
Intermediarie	Advisory organizations
Technical ass providers	Social consultancy organizations, law firms, think tanks, universities
Evaluators	Research institutes, academics, professional services firms
