Dr. Yolanda Álvarez is a grant writing coordinator and project manager of European industry-academia projects (FP7 / H2020). Her mission is creating and managing new links between public and private sectors (parallel disconnected worlds, that speak different languages but have so much to share and learn from each other), in order to join efforts for a better science: dignified (properly funded) and translational (to improve the health of the society). Currently she is dedicated to the management of FP7-IAPP-3DNET and H2020-RISE-3D-NEONET projects, in which several companies and universities of 7 different countries are struggling to develop therapies for cancer and incurable eye disease.
