PRACTICAL INFORMATION

The meeting will be held in the **Room 'Willem Elsschotzaal'** of the historic 'Hof van Liere' building at the [City Campus of Antwerp University](#) (Prinsstraat 13, 2000 Antwerp). The campus is located in the historical centre of Antwerp and the main train station (Central Station) is within walking distance. Please see map in the next page.

How to get there

From Brussels-Zaventem Airport:

A. Take the train to conveniently travel from Brussels Airport to Antwerp Central Station. Brussels Airport-Zaventem station is located on level -1 of the terminal, at a small distance from the arrivals hall (2nd floor) and the departures hall (3rd floor). The trip lasts ~38 minutes, and the fare is 11.60 EUR. Info: <https://www.belgianrail.be/en/>

B. There is also a Antwerp-Brussels Airport express. The stop "Kon. Astridplein" (near the central station) is always served, the stop "Crowne Plaza" is only served on request. First departure 3am, last departure midnight, travel time 45 minutes. Tickets: 10 EUR.
