

Research question:

Impact of a foreign youth transfer on:

- Sporting performance;
- Player financials;

Special focus: English Premier League.

















LITERATURE REVIEW

Reasons for exodus of young talent:

- Success of Belgian National Team;
- Cost of acquiring youngsters is low.







LITERATURE REVIEW

Potential drawbacks:

- Intense competition:
 - Limited first team opportunities in EPL;
 - Essential for youth development;
- <u>Ties fall away</u>:
 - Language barriers;
 - Family and friends far away.





LITERATURE REVIEW

Attraction for players?

Short-term financial perks:

- Sign-on bonus;
- Job for parents.

METHODOLOGY AND DATA

Panel data: regression techniques

- Compare players:
 - Who stayed and left during youth;
 - Before and after move;
- Control for other unobservable effects.





METHODOLOGY AND DATA

Dependent variables:

- <u>Sporting performance</u>: SciSkill index;
- <u>Financial</u>: Market value (correlated with wage);

Independent variables:

- Playing minutes, team strength, age, loan, caps;
- Country of last academy.



Performance (SciSkill)





RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Different models tested:

- <u>Negative impact</u> of moving to England;
- Minors moving to <u>England</u>:
 - Perform worse in the start of their career;
 - Earn lower wages.
- Effect not significant for other countries.





RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Different models tested:

- <u>Positive impact</u> on player development of:
 - First team minutes;
 - Gaining experience in a strong team;
- <u>National team</u> exposure increases a player's market value.











CONCLUSIONS AND FUTURE RESEARCH

Conclusion:

Youth players who stay in Belgium have higher chances for a better career, compared to:

- Youth players in England who risk ending up significantly worse;
- But: no significant difference for other countries.





CONCLUSION AND FUTURE RESEARCH

Future research:

- Test effect of other variables (e.g. injuries);
- Test more model specifications (e.g. dynamic models);
- Check robustness of results for players from other countries.
